Hawai'i Adventure Itinerary*

Friday – July 23 – Flights from across the country arriving in Vancouver. Travellers join with the Vancouver group, all departing on Air Canada flight 047 , departing at 18:45. Arrive in Honolulu at 21:45. Receive a traditional Hawaiian Lei greeting. Collect luggage, and board transfer to the Ala Moana Hotel (www.alamoanahotel.com). Go to sleep in paradise! (earthly)

Saturday – July 24 – Awake at your leisure. Spend some time getting settled, or exploring the adventures waiting to be discovered outside your door. Free until 4pm, when we depart for our Sunset Dinner Cruise. “Experience a wonderful Hawaiian evening aboard the *state-of-the-art Navatek I* and create a lifetime of memories as you explore our majestic coastal waters surrounding Waikiki and Honolulu. Known for its ability to most comfortably take-on the seas past famous **Diamond Head**, get your chance to see the hidden shores of **Kahala**, home to Hawaii's rich and famous! “ We will arrive back to our hotel at approximately 8pm.

Sunday – July 25 – Morning is free to explore on your own, or perhaps attend a local worship service. (<http://www.waikikibaptist.com/index.htm>) Remainder of day is currently free.

Monday – July 26 – We depart at approximately 10am for a narrated scenic drive to the Polynesian Cultural Centre (www.polynesia.com), for a full day immersed in the history and culture of the Polynesian peoples. Experience cultural “villages”, enjoy a Prime rib/seafood buffet dinner, and then witness the show, “Ha, Breath of Life”, returning to hotel by approximately 10pm.

Tuesday – July 27 – Today starts early! (who wants to sleep away their time in paradise?) We board our transportation for our visit to Pearl Harbour, The Arizona Memorial, and a circle tour of the island, visiting many of the must see sights and attractions around Oahu. We return to our hotel around 5pm. Evening is free for your own interests.

Monday – August 2 – Arrive Vancouver at 07:45. Board connecting flights to your departure city, as you recall all of your wonderful vacation memories! Depending on your specific connecting flights, arrive home throughout the day.
