Associate Pastor (emphasis on Student Ministry) Job Description

Summerside Baptist Church is seeking an Associate Pastor who will join our pastoral team to give leadership to Student Ministry (Kindergarten to College). We would love to see our Student Ministry become the leading edge of our church.

SBC has a congregation of around 200 people in a community of over 15,000 residents. The current Student Ministry consists of mid-week youth group, Sunday morning youth ministry, a youth worship team, Sunday children's ministry, and regular special events. The successful candidate for this position will take the lead in discipling our current students, mobilizing them to serve, and reaching out to new students in the Summerside area.

Attributes and Qualifications

- A deep, growing, personal faith in Jesus Christ
- A passion to help people believe in Jesus and follow Jesus
- Experience working with children, junior high, and high school students
- Strong communication and time management skills
- Energetic, fun-loving and enthusiastic with a positive attitude
- Good understanding of youth culture and how to make faith relevant to life
- Strong convictions with a generous spirit
- Ability to plan, develop, organize, and carry out ministry programs and events effectively
- A collaborative person who desires to involve people and to build a strong team

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Lead weekly programs for Student Ministry.
2. Develop a system to disciple students so that they grow in their faith.
3. Create outreach opportunities to reach new students.
4. Activate students to serve in local, regional and global mission.
5. Care for and connect with students, parents and volunteers on a regular basis.
6. Recruit, train and encourage volunteers to work in Student Ministry.
7. Plan regular youth events and outings.
8. Take part in appropriate rallies and mission events, with an emphasis on getting involved in Canadian Baptist of Atlantic Canada activities.
9. Support leaders and volunteers in the Christian Education ministry. Select curriculum, coordinate, equip, and assist, as required.
10. Ensure ministry is happening among young adults.
11. Be involved with Camp Seggie.
12. Communicate with church, students and parents through email, phone, and social media.
13. Oversee and participate in Vacation Bible Camp.
14. Work closely with the Lead Pastor to champion the vision, involve the Body in ministry, and pastor the people.

15. Belong to a Home Church within SBC.
16. Preach and lead worship in consultation with the Lead Pastor and Deacons.
17. Perform other duties, as required.

Accountability and Reporting

As a member of the pastoral staff, the Pastor will:

- Be accountable to the Lead Pastor and Deacons, with whom they form a leadership team.
- Report regularly to Church Council and attend Church Council as required.
- Lead Christian Education meetings.
- Attend meetings of other boards and committees of the church as requested.
- Provide annual written reports for Student Ministries and Christian Education.
- Recommend items for the annual church budget and be good steward of the Christian Ed budget.

Salary
