IS THE OLD REALLY BETTER?

f you are like most people, you don't like change. I remember many years ago preaching a sermon on the **need for change** and I cited one of Jesus' parables. Jesus said, no one sews a new patch on an old garment and no one pours new wine into old wineskins (Luke 5:36-39). After the sermon as

I greeted people at the door, one older gentleman who was a farmer looked at me and said, "The old is better!" I knew from his comment that I should make a pastoral visit. We talked about many things and agreed to disagree on a few things but I realized how deeply rooted his resistance to change really was when I looked at the clock in his kitchen. He indicated that he didn't bother to adjust his clock to

daylight savings time because that would involve change!

Jesus was calling for change - change of heart, change of mind, change of direction. He was calling upon religious people to change their way of seeing God and seeing the world. Jesus preached, "Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is near" (Matthew 4:17)! Jesus challenged the status quo and declared a radical new way of being that would shatter long held paradigms for religious people. The good news is that the message of the Kingdom resonated with many other people who did "repent (change)" and become transformed to be followers of Jesus.

As I age, I find myself tempted to be more like the farmer in my church who said, "The



old is better!" At the same time I want to remain open to change because I believe God wants to do new things. Through the prophet Ezekiel, God said, "And I will give them a new heart, and put a new spirit within them" (Ezekiel 11:19). God wants to give you and me a new heart and a new vision for what God can do in Atlantic Canada. The question remains, "Are we willing to change", or will we

say, "The old is better"?

This proposal represents significant change in the way we do ministry together and we need you to be well informed as we discuss and vote on this proposal in August.


