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INVITATION TO CONNECT 2012

CONNECT 2012 is a series of regional gatherings for pastors and church leaders to be held in September and October. The purpose of these consultations is to **Connect** (fellowship), **Consult** (we want to hear from you) and **Communicate** (updating you on some future initiatives). In the afternoon a workshop will be held on "Preventing Destructive Conflict in the Local Congregation". The day will begin at 9:30am, lunch provided by host church (offering will be taken) and the afternoon workshop will conclude by 3pm.

The host of these consultations will be Rev. Greg Jones. Greg is currently a member of the CABC Transition Team (Leadership Support and Development) and Director of Development, and he will be one of the new Associate Executive Ministers. Where possible other CABC staff members will be in attendance. We hope that you will join us for this event. One of the reasons we are hosting these regional consultations is that with the transition from Regional Ministers, we as the CABC are looking for ways to remain connected with Pastors and churches.
