WHEREAS the present trend in the Atlantic Provinces is to secularize Sunday and to offer entertainment and sports on a commercial basis; and

WHEREAS a movement has been made to change and relax the Lord's Day Act;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Convention appeal to its member churches to take a united stand against any change in the Lord's Day Act that would tend to commercialize Sunday;

AND FURTHERMORE that we appeal to our pastors and church leaders to include in their Christian education programs the biblical teaching of the observance of the Lord's Day as a day of rest and worship.
