

Alcohol: Air Traffic Safety (1966)

WHEREAS Air Canada has recently declared its intention to introduce liquor service in its flights within Canada and is known to have urged introduction of legislation to permit such service in the respective Provinces.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Convention be recorded as firmly opposed to the introduction of this additional and unwarranted air-traffic hazard on any and all air service in Canada, and that our opposition be communicated to our respective Provincial Governments, to Air Canada, and to the Air Transport Authority at Ottawa.
