

**Job Description for Part-Time Interim Youth Pastor
First United Baptist Church, New Glasgow
(20 hours per week)**

Position Summary:

The Youth Pastor shall be responsible for ensuring youth are introduced to Jesus Christ and grow in Christian life with the support of the First United Baptist Church family.

Qualifications:

1. A born again believer, committed Christian
2. The ability to teach and organize youth and their church leaders. This includes sharing experiences in one-on-one, small and large group settings.
3. An understanding and adherence to the principles of Baptist faith, with commitment to the mission and beliefs specific to FUBC.
4. Effective use of communication skills to engage family members and build meaningful relationships with youth.
5. A willingness to complete a criminal records check and child abuse registry inquiry.

Responsibilities:

1. The youth pastor is accountable to the Board of Deacons as the spiritual leadership of the church. Curriculum and program planning will fall under the general leadership of the Christian Education Board of FUBC. The youth pastor will make monthly reports to both boards.
2. The youth pastor will develop and lead youth groups that incorporate a love for God's word.(grades P-3, 4-6, and 7-12)
3. The youth pastor will organize and coordinate the Sunday morning children's program
4. The youth pastor will recruit, train and mobilize a team of adults to assist with the youth ministry.
5. The youth pastor will strive to make connections with youth attending FUBC and within the wider community of Pictou County.
6. The youth pastor will establish, develop and maintain relationships with youth and their families.
7. The youth pastor will establish a presence at FUBC by being accessible to the congregation on a regular basis.
8. The youth pastor will, in partnership with the Board of Christian Education, explore, plan and participate in ministry opportunities for young families at FUBC.
9. The youth pastor will encourage and lead youth participation in the activities provided by the Convention of the Atlantic Baptist churches and the wider Baptist community, which include but are not limited to, Spring Forth, Challenge, and Tidal Impact.
