Pastor of Young Families & Worship

Kingsboro Baptist Church & South Lake Christian Church

This position requires the ability to work well with others, be self-directed, creative, and able to formulate and transfer ideas into active ministry – an individual who will lead by example in carrying out this ministry, while developing others. This position requires a strong sense of call to this particular type of ministry and a person who has a close walk with Christ and sensitivity to His direction.

Primary Focus

- **1.** Equip youth (grades 7-12) and their parents to integrate their faith with life experience in the home, friendships, church, school, community and workplace.
- **2.** Strengthen the music ministry of the Kingsboro Church for the purpose of creating an atmosphere of Worship for all ages.

Responsibilities

- Work with Pastor Jason and our church family in developing a Vision for Family & Worship Ministries.
- **2.** Recruit, develop and support members of our congregations in family, and music ministry leadership roles.
- **3.** Facilitate solid holistic Bible teaching and Prayer opportunities for youth and their parents.
- **4.** Direct our weekly middle school and high school youth group ministries.
- **5.** Connect with teens and their parents in our church, community and schools.
- **6.** Help develop service and outreach opportunities for our Church families in reaching our community for Christ.
- Direct our Music Ministry particularly (but not limited to) Sunday mornings in Kingsboro by selecting music (hymns and choruses) and developing and leading a worship team and band by incorporating teens and adults.
- **8.** Preach in our morning services from time to time.
- **9.** Promote participation in the ministries of the Convention of Atlantic Baptist Churches, Christian Church Denomination and interdenominational camps, youth rallies, etc.
- 10. 10. Although the Pastor of Young Families & Worship is not responsible for carrying out our Children's Ministry (infants grade 6), all Children's Ministries will be accountable to the Pastor of Young Families & Worship for the purpose of moving our full family ministry in one direction. Pastor Jason will help oversee this area of ministry as the Pastor of Young Families and Worship needs his help.

Time Commitments

- Two days a week off and four vacation weeks will be coordinated with the Lead Pastor
- > Hours of work will include evenings and weekends
- > Meet weekly with the Lead Pastor for planning, support and prayer.

Qualifications

- An accredited and ordained Pastor (or working towards ordination) with an MDIV in Pastoral Ministry with a strong focus on Youth and Family is preferable.
- Should be able to play a Musical Instrument and must be gifted in Leading Worship and building a Worship Team and Band.
- > Have experience in this type of ministry.
- Be in agreement/support the ministries, beliefs, goals and aims of our two Churches, the Convention of Atlantic Baptist Churches & the Christian Church Denomination.

Salary, Housing and Benefits
