Full Time Family Ministries Position

Background -

Stevens Road United Baptist Church (SRUBC) has been part of the local community for over 65 years by providing support to people of all ages and backgrounds, with an emphasis on spiritual care, in a holistic manner that impacts our community and beyond. In its history, SRUBC has played an important role in the community, assisting other organizations such as the local Breakfast Program, Food Bank, Divorce Care, etc. Besides our Sunday (in person & online) services, we offer year-round children, youth and family programs that are open to the community.

Our church facilities are used by a variety of local groups for such things as concerts, receptions, meetings, courses, sporting activities, etc. SRUBC has also supported many programs with funds to assist people around the world by providing education for women and children, clean drinking water, and preventing disease to give a few examples. Summer months are traditionally the busiest time at SRUBC when students and others have joined our Summer Team allowing us to offer additional children and youth programs and activities along with fun events for the seniors in our church as well as the local community.

SRUBC is also an active member of a local business association called *Village on Main*. It is also part of an ecumenical group of churches that support the East Dartmouth Christian Food Bank, and Feeding Others Of Dartmouth (FOOD or Margaret's House) as well as a shared Good Friday service. We are a member of the Halifax Regional United Baptist Association (HRUBA) and the Canadian Baptists of Atlantic Canada (CBAC), with strong ties to Canadian Baptist Ministries (CBM) and Bayside Camp.

Position -

We are looking for a Family Ministries Candidate to join our Ministry Team. This candidate may be appointed as the *Director - OR - Associate Pastor* of Family Ministries, depending on their qualifications and career goals.

The candidate will, in the spirit of Ephesians 4:12, equip the church to live the gospel out in their homes and interactions throughout the week.

Focus areas for this position are -

- 1. Equipping Individuals with knowledge about God and godliness
- 2. Equipping Individuals with knowledge about worshiping as a family
- 3. Encourage and Support family interactions

Full Time Family Ministries Position

The ideal candidate is someone who is willing to grow with, and into, the role presented, as well as grow and develop the role based on their strengths and abilities.

Candidates will be asked to demonstrate:

- They are a committed Christian with beliefs compatible with those of SRUBC as located on stevensroadbaptist.ca/mission-and-vision
- They are willing to share their faith in both group situations and on an individual level
- They have undergone training and have experience working with youth and families
- They are able to work with volunteers
- They are an effective trainer, recruiter, communicator, and motivator
- They have a valid Driver's license
- Theological education or training and willingness to undertake further training or studies considered an asset

Candidates must undergo a criminal record check and child abuse registry search.

Candidates must be comfortable with presenting live online and being recorded for broadcast.

Desirable Characteristics:

- Creative, energetic, and enthusiastic
- Strong organizational skills
- Team player
- Able to accept direction and feedback
- Willing to continue with personal spiritual education and growth
- Conflict resolution abilities
- Financially responsible
- Comfortable with social media and graphic design websites such as Canva

Responsibilities:

- Establish and build relationships with children, youth and families
- Provide strategies to help parents disciple their children
- Coordinate, Maintain and Evaluate programs such as: Sunday School, Youth Group, Vacation Bible School, Family Days, Career Aged Group, Nursery and Toddler programming, Tidal Impact (or equivalent), Bible Studies
- Recruit, train and support leaders to work in family ministry
- Support Canadian Baptists of Atlantic Canada (CBAC), Bayside Camp and Halifax Regional Association (HRUBA) Activities
- Foster in-church relationships
- Assist in Sunday Worship, through regularly leading the morning service and planning / preparing "Youth and Family Focused" worship services
 - Worship Team presence considered an asset
 - Preaching as coordinated with Lead Pastor considered an asset

Full Time Family Ministries Position

Other:

- This position works closely with the Lead Pastor
- This position is accountable to the Membership, via the Christian Education Committee
- This position is hybrid (working in office is required, as coordinated with the Lead Pastor)
