### Description:

The candidate must have a combination of administrative and leadership capabilities combined with a proven history of demonstrating initiative, creativity, vision, and positive work ethics. Most importantly, the **Associate Pastor of Connections** is currently engaged in a healthy, growing relationship with Jesus Christ evidenced by action, attitude, and behavior in support of their call to serve the Body of Christ.

### Responsibilities:

The **Associate Pastor of Connections** reports to the Senior Pastor and is responsible for four key areas of the ministry:

1. **Oversight and Execution of First Impressions.** The individual will be expected to create an environment that welcomes new guests and provides next steps toward connection and spiritual growth.
2. **Discipleship and Small Group Ministry.** The successful applicant will work with small group coordinators to develop practical strategies and systems to help people move from visiting to belonging and growing.
3. **Facilitate Connections to Volunteer Ministry Teams.** The individual will work with ministry leaders to help people discover their God-given gifts and connect them to a ministry.
4. **Develop and Manage a Pastoral Care Strategy.** The successful applicant will work with the pastoral team and other care ministry leaders to build and implement a pastoral care ministry team to meet the needs of the congregation.

### Qualifications:

- A Bachelor's Degree in Ministry, or the equivalent with two or more years of relevant experience working in a culturally diverse congregation.
- Ordained minister, or in pursuit of ordination accredited by the Board of Ministerial Standards and Education of the Canadian Baptist of Atlantic Canada, or equivalent.
