



church with an average weekly attendance of 65. We have a multi-cultural and multi-generational congregation that enjoys a pipe organ and an active choir.



Our congregation has been active in refugee sponsorship for over 20 years, has facilitated short term mission trips, and had various downtown ministry opportunities, one of which is our licensed daycare that has operated for over 50 years. Along with a number of other CBWC Baptist Churches we support our camp, The Quest at Christopher Lake.

We are a member of the Inner-City Council of Churches which gives us the opportunity to develop inter-denominational relationships, and we provide an open Sunday morning service which welcomes those of other denominations to join us in worship and communion. Our congregation currently shares our building with an Eritrean congregation.
