Overview of Position:

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The Pastor will serve as the spiritual leader of the flock of God which gathers at Saint Thomas Baptist Church and the community of North Preston. Faithfully preach God's Word and model the priority of prayer and discipleship within the Church. Work in conjunction with the Executives in formulating Policy Statements as may be required. Give oversight and direction to all ministries & works, with the Board of Leaders to establish and implement the vision.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Present the message during Sunday service and lead the weekly prayer and bible study.
- Pastor is to lead the congregation in the Lord's Supper and to shut-ins.
- Develop and train new Deacons
- The Pastor will oversee the christian education of all ages
- Officiate at funerals, weddings and child dedications as requested and provide marriage counselling and baptismal classes as required.
- Provide counselling to those in need and recommend the appropriate services available.

- The Pastor will attend all regular, annual, and special church meetings and, also fulfill duties on the African United Baptist Association (AUBA) of Nova Scotia Executive. The Pastor will also normally attend AUBA sessions and the Annual Assembly of Convention.
- The Pastor will provide written reports at monthly Deacon's meetings as well as Church Quarterly and Annual Business meetings. These reports will contain important details such as progress towards achieving identified church goals, number of visits made, positive ministry situations, problem situations including resolution, church and community involvement, AUBA and Convention duties as applicable.
