With a congregation of approximately 300 worshipers including in person and online each week, our church is on a transformative journey guided by our "<u>Vision 2027</u>" plans. First Baptist Church is part of <u>Canadian Baptist of Atlantic Canada</u>.

Position Summary:

FBC is seeking a Pastor of Youth and Young Adults to join our Next Gen Ministry Team. This part-time role will contribute to the leadership of a vibrant youth ministry and a developing young adult ministry, which are aligned with the overall mission and vision of the church.

Roles/Responsibilities:

Youth Ministry

- 1. Lead a Christ-centered community for youth (Grade 7 to Grade 12) that emphasizes peer relationships, faith exploration, and ongoing discipleship and mentorship into adulthood in a fun and safe environment.
- 2. Lead and oversee the execution of the weekly youth night, "Solid Rock Youth"
- 3. Adhere to safety policies and parental communication expectations for all FBC-sanctioned ministries involving minors and vulnerable individuals.
- 4. Implement "structured flexibility" in the youth ministry schedule, fostering additional opportunities for gatherings, which could include partnering together with other youth groups on PEI.
- 5. Work alongside and support a team of dedicated volunteer leaders, ensuring their commitment is rewarding and beneficial to their own spiritual growth.
- 6. Grow in increased awareness of the changing social/cultural/ spiritual and technological needs of the demographic being served and seek biblically to relevantly incorporate such needs into FBC's youth ministry.
- 7. Foster collaboration with the Pastor of Children and Families to facilitate a smooth transition from Kidz Church to Solid Rock Youth.

8. Know and become known by the congregation at large as an interested, engaged pastoral leader within the ministry team. This means having a broad interest in all the people of the church, not simply a narrow interest exclusive to those connected to Solid Rock Youth.

Young Adults

- 1. Oversee and guide the young adults ministry at FBC and work with a developing leadership team to enhance the ministry.
- 2. Continue to develop the vision for young adult ministry at FBC.
- 3. Be available as a resource and liaison with those in the college and career age group.
- 4. Provide spiritual guidance and support to young adults
- 5. Help plan and execute events

Reporting/Working Relationships:

- Directly accountable to the Pastoral Team Lead.
- Relationally responsible to the entire ministry team for collegial support and collaboration.
- Participate in weekly staff meetings as called by the Pastoral Team Lead
- Regular communication with the Board of Deacons through monthly reports and attendance at meetings as requested.

Character/Personal Attributes:

- Exhibit personal integrity, a strong Christian faith, self-awareness, and a commitment to building the kingdom.
- Cultivate a listening attitude, remaining open to constructive critique and insights for personal, professional and spiritual growth.
- Demonstrate effective communication with students, parents, congregants, and volunteers, displaying timely and thoughtful responses.
- Strong leadership and organizational skills.
- Ability to work well in a team.
- Willing to invest in the lives of the youth and young adults and have a heart for this age group.
