

DELEGATE PROCESS FAQ

Sending a church team to the CBAC Justice Summit? Here's all you need to know.

WHY DELEGATES?

At the heart of the CBAC Justice Summit is an invitation to move from education to action. Our vision is to equip CBAC churches to engage in neighborhood level justice initiatives in their own local context.

With that vision in mind, we see the Justice Summit as an intentional leadership development opportunity. A delegate process ensures that participants are serious about next steps, and churches are 'bought in' to the vision. Through a delegate process we are asking churches to partner with us in raising up leaders to more effectively join God in our neighborhoods.



WHO WOULD MAKE A GREAT DELEGATE?

The CBAC Justice Summit is ideal for passionate, open-minded individuals that are ready to take the next step from education to action. We are inviting our CBAC churches to identify these people, and send teams of delegates passionate about working towards biblical justice in their neighborhoods.

Delegates can be pastors, lay leaders, teens and young adults, members of a mission board or justice committee, or congregants with a real passion to work towards change!



CAN MY CHURCH SEND MORE THAN ONE DELEGATE?

Yes! Your church is invited to send a team that can include as many people as you'd like. We think these teams could form the foundation of your future 'justice leadership' at your church.



WHAT IS THE PROCESS FOR SELECTING DELEGATES?

Churches should follow their own processes for delegate selection. The Justice Summit will not include voting on any official CBAC 'business,' so you may not need to be as thorough in your nominations as you may be for an event like Oasis. We suggest simply putting out the call to your church congregants, tapping a few people on the shoulder, and empowering your next-generation leadership to put a team together!



WHEN SHOULD I ASSEMBLE A TEAM?

As soon as possible! The Justice Summit is scheduled for November 4th and 5th, so we encourage churches to begin having conversations with potential delegates as soon as possible. We also recommend taking 3 weeks to move through the prep-work.



HOW DO I REGISTER A TEAM?

Simply register online through our website https://baptistatlantic.ca/event/justicesummit/

We suggest one point person to register the full group. If your church sends a group of 4+ people, you can receive a 10% discount off the registration.

NOTE: Registrations must be completed together in 1 transaction to qualify for this discount.

You will be prompted to select the number of team members for your church and fill in relevant information for each person.

CAN I REGISTER AS AN INDIVIDUAL?

Yes! We believe this work is made stronger in community, but if your church is not ready to put together a team, don't let that stop you from attending the Justice Summit. There is room for everyone at the table.
