January 1

Happy New Year! Join us in prayer for a new year of ministry in our churches, schools, and neighbourhoods. Pray for a fruitful year of kingdom work in 2023 and that God will lead our ministry leaders toward his will for the communities they serve. Pray for renewed strength, energy, and passion to move forward into all this new year holds.

January 8

Pray for students heading into a new semester at Acadia Divinity College and Crandall University. Pray that they would move into this new semester feeling rested, renewed, and focused as they take on new courses. Pray for the students, staff, faculties and boards of these schools. Pray for all the relationships that are being formed on and off campus, and that both of these schools would be places of growth, learning, and spiritual development for those who attend.

January 15

Pray for our leaders of next generation ministries who are serving our young people in Atlantic Canada. Pray that God would be at work in their ministries and guide them with wisdom as they connect with, mentor, and lead the children and youth in their communities.

January 22
